***Welcome Jr's and parents to the 2009 Jr 330 Friday night racing program.**
This end of the month Friday event is sponsored by Gaged Eng. "the Clutch Co and Rolling Thunder Drag Strip.

****Rules-**This is a fast moving and "Fun" program designed to give the Jr a chance to dial in race on a Pro Tree to the 330 mark. All NHRA rules apply towards speed and safety.
No Jr will be allowed to exceed the NHRA JR speed limit when crossing the 1/8th stripe.
Jr's can run out to the 330 and then get out of the throttle quickly as they need to slow to the 1/8th.

****Qualify----** All Jr's will be ready and in cars for the 1st qualifying round to be ran at 7pm sharp. Qualifying is on a pro ladder with a .40 tenths tree. Reaction times will determine the Eliminations positioning in the ladder fastest vs. slowest. You will pull up under the canopy left and right in 2 lanes and you can have a chance to run left or right lanes as you will get 2 qualifying hits. Again the first one is at 7pm and the second will be at 8pm with the first round of eliminations at 8:30pm. This is single eliminations and afterwards if you would like to test and tune, get in the right hand lane and be ready after Elimination rounds.

******Prizing-----Winner gets-----\$100 cash**
Runner Up gets-----\$75 cash
Best reaction during Qualifying-----\$50 cash
Lowest ET-----\$25 cash

*****All prizing to be paid at the end of the night. Around 11pm.**

*******Safety—**All Jr's are absolutely required to pull over at the ET shack and off to the side. Absolutely no driving back on the return road or you will be suspended from the facility. No unlicensed drivers are allowed less than 16 years of age to drive a pit vehicle of any kind, this includes skateboards, bikes, roller blades or any other non NHRA approved vehicles. All violators will be escorted off the premises by staff and or the Mills county sheriffs dept.

Friday nights are a Street Race night and we do have to keep things rolling for the good of this facility, so lets make sure we are ready, in our cars with safety gear on and ready to run as Jim calls you to the lanes.
